Our visit to the iconic Kennedy Space Center (KSC) in Florida was an unforgettable experience. From the awe-inspiring Vehicle Assembly Building (VAB), where rockets are prepared for launch, to standing beneath the towering rockets in the Rocket Garden, every moment ignited our curiosity.

We marvelled at the Atlantis Shuttle, which completed 33 missions and the thrilling simulator experience gave us a glimpse into an astronaut's life. The highlight was meeting Bob Cenker, an astronaut from the STS-61-C mission, who shared inspiring stories about teamwork, perseverance and chasing dreams. His words reminded us that space exploration is about courage and the relentless pursuit of knowledge. We also learned about NASA's commitment to preserving wildlife habitats, saving over 133,000 acres of land for animals—a beautiful testament to balancing progress with care for Earth.

Beyond KSC, we visited Niagara Falls, MIT and Harvard, the Statue of Liberty, and enjoyed fun-filled moments at Universal Studios and Sea World. This trip was not just about sightseeing—it was about discovering possibilities, embracing innovation and learning that the universe has no limits when we dare to dream.






> <u>EXCURSION:</u> The Class 10 students of the 2024-25 batch went on an excursion to Hyderabad and had a wonderful time.
