<u>Following are the points from the President's address to the PTA members</u> and report on academic by the Coordinators:

- → Pre Primary Coordinator Mrs. Sonia Madtha briefed the gathering on the academics activities, extra-curricular activities, inter-school story competition which was newly introduced that is story telling competition which will happen shortly
- → Primary Coordinator Mrs. Cicily Galaster appreciated the parents for being approachable and also requested their support for the upcoming events.
- → Middle and Secondary School Coordinator Mrs. Nirmala Jones shared the following:-
 - 1) The special classes are arranged for the students for those who have missed out the regular classes attending other activities and it is not repetitive but it is helping them in keeping up their attendance and catching up with the rest of the class

 - 4) Class test was being informed prior to the students however, hereafter it will not be informed.
 - 5) Kala Utsav was conducted for showcasing and nurturing the talents but much to the dismay, did not receive enthusiastic participation from the higher class
 - Requested parents to support for the inter-school competition which are being introduced in coming days.
- → Primary Coordinator Mrs. Bency Johanas appreciated parents for the rendered support for Kala Utsav. Extra classes are conducted for Kannada and Hindi. Timetable and Portion for the upcoming half Yearly exam will be uploaded shortly.



The members discussed few points about academics as follows:-

- Parent expressed that the 3rd language is less in syllabus so more of analytics should be taught to the students.
- Std 1 & 2 robotics syllabus is not clearly conveyed, what is been done
 in class so Coordinator Mrs. Cicily conveyed that the activity is
 conducted as per the syllabus however will check on how to convey.
 Principal stated that the curriculum is given by robotics team however
 it will be uploaded in ParentConnect.
- Parent suggested for 1 day Millets meal for students.
- Parent asked what the use of journal? So principal answered that the students will be writing the journal wherein they express their feelings and emotions which may be helpful in the future for selfintrospection.
- Parent appreciated management, on the successful conduct of Kala utsav event as it was wonderful and teachers were very supportive to the students and also fo reducing the weight of the school bag.
- Parent requested to continue giving old books to school as it reduces the heavy load fo the bag and teaches social and additional responsibilities to the students. Also not to let the students of classes 1 to 4 to the canteen.
- Parent requested for transportation after sports activities.

- Parent requested to control students in bus as they bully and make a lot of noise so principal stated that he has already arranged conductors to do the needful and also the transport in charge will be taking care of it.
- Parent suggested if we could have French language however principal expressed that he has been seeing other school struggling to get teachers for French as we need many teachers so we have not opted for it.
- Parent questioned that Std 9th project is given and its excellent but what is the outcome from the project? Coordinator Mrs. Nirmala expressed that the topics/assignments are followed according to the syllabus prescribed by the CISCE Board.
- Parent requested for career guidance sessions& an overview of competitive exams for grade 9 students.
- Parent shared that the prizes were not distributed to all students in the previous sports day event as some children who didn't receive were disappointed.
- Parent requested the school to put in little more effort to teach grammar in languages as the students have lost two crucial learning years.
- Parent expressed that the meeting of teachers must be arranged individually however principal stated that it is already mentioned in handbook regarding Wednesday 3-4pm.

- Parent requested for a psychologist for the behavioral issues so principal stated that there is already counsellor in the school.
- Sr KG students cannot communicate what has been taught. Exactly
 where the child has to improve in academic should be conveyed to the
 parent.
- Principal reiterated that parents have to contact first contact the School office.
- Principal asked all the Parent Members to give their Mail IDs to the school which the school will pass on to all the parents. So that they can communicate their views to them.
